

# Message From Rabbi Goldstein

When you fracture your arm, like I managed to do in mid-June, you are faced with an extended period of imposed isolation. I was lucky that Sally was always near to help, but the overwhelming reality was that I needed to fill my days with some substance while I recovered. Now that I'm back to near normality, I can look back and recognize three areas that bolstered me.

First, I received so many phone calls, letters and contributions from the Sha'arey Ha-Yam community in honor of my recovery. I eventually gave up on writing thank-you notes to everyone, since I had limited mobility. So this will have to do: I am a lucky rabbi to lead such a warm and caring community in Sha'arey Ha-Yam. Every time I heard from you it made me feel missed and needed. I am grateful beyond words.

Second, I used much of my time by channeling my Judaism. In other words I studied and read a bit more. I started planning my adult education classes and my High Holyday sermons. One morning I prayed with "tefillin". And I was reminded of what I want all of us to know: In moments of isolation and trial, our tradition can bolster us with faith, passion and hope.

Finally, I recognized that my month of limited mobility could be understood as a metaphor for preparation for the Days of Awe, themselves. After all, we will soon be challenged, on Rosh Ha'Shanah and Yom Kippur, to be alone with our thoughts and our self-introspection. For me, when I fractured my arm, I reflected about aspects of my life and how I need to reach for higher standards, often writing out my thoughts long-hand. It was an exercise in self-awareness that our tradition calls for in each of us as we approach the High Holydays. That willingness to evaluate our lives is truly the best preparation for 5778.

May all of us be written and inscribed for a year of sweetness, health...and mobility!

### President's Message

We've reached the time of year when the leaves are changing color, the nights are cool, and the birds are flying in formation. The summer has come to an end....no more barbeques or pool parties or watching sunsets on the beach after 8 PM for this year.

I am looking forward to the Fall holidays, starting with Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. For me, the Days of Awe are an opportunity to take stock of my life – what have I done well and what do I need to work on in the coming year. Have I been generous with my time, giving back to my community, supporting family, friends and work colleagues? Have I given to charity? Have I been tolerant or short-tempered?

During this period, I take the words "teshuva, tefilah and tzedakah....repentence, prayer and good deeds" more seriously than the rest of the year. That's not to say that I don't have an ongoing dialogue with God all year long; or that I let any difficulties with loved ones go on for days or months without resolution (I'm good about taking ownership of fault even when I'm not to blame.....Jewish guilt I guess); and I am as generous as possible with my time and finances within our Sha'arey Ha-Yam community and my larger community.

This is a time when I always ask myself if there's more I can do and somehow, someway, the answer is always YES. This year, I am asking all of you to do the same. I'm asking you to consider a little extra *tzedakah* for Sha'arey Ha-Yam. I'm asking for your time to serve on a Committee. I'm also asking that each of you to make a special Rosh Hashanah contribution of whatever you can afford. We have work to do this year to build our Congregation and that takes all of us.....not just the Executive Board and our Committee Chairpeople. The work we need to do is going to take time and be moderately expensive but in the end, it will be well worth the time and money.

Finally, let me take this opportunity to wish you all a happy and healthy 5778..... L'shanah tovah tikatev v'taihatemi, May you be inscribed and sealed for a good year!
